Expanding beyond golf, STRYKR introduces Australia's second URBAN SHANX mini golf course, a contemporary, high-design adventure that serves as an engaging entry point for families, non-golfers, and young people. Complementing this are two state-of-the-art padel courts, with plans for two more, bringing the world's fastest-growing racket sport - a dynamic hybrid of tennis and squash - to Adelaide for the first time integrated with other sports. Padel's enclosed courts emphasise strategy, collaboration, and social play, making it easy to learn and highly addictive.



The vision behind STRYKR is to create a welcoming hub that redefines recreation in South Australia. By harmonising low-impact design with the coastal surroundings - featuring a natural colour palette and a central courtyard for gatherings - STRYKR fosters community wellbeing, economic growth, and environmental sensitivity. This rebranding signals a new era of accessibility, where golf evolves into diverse formats to attract new participants, strengthen local bonds, and position Port Noarlunga as a premier destination.

"Our goal with STRYKR is to strike a perfect balance between innovation, site sensitivity, and community value," said Peter Vlahandreas, Managing Director of GreenSpace Management. "This fresh start transforms a beloved local asset into a modern space that invites everyone to connect, play, and thrive. We're excited to launch in this new image and era, building on our award-winning track record to make golf and recreation more inclusive than ever."
